Subject:  June 6 Steering Committee Meeting Notes

Hi Steering Committee,

Thanks for attending our check in on Tuesday. I wanted to send out a quick list of things we talked about:

- For Step 3 communications, we will work to have steering committee meetings a few days before each Stakeholder meeting. Steering committee members will be invited to attend technical committee meetings if they want to get more involved in the details of the project.
- Make sure to share parameters (sideboards, goals, constraints, guidelines) for step 2 at the June 21 Stakeholder Meeting
- Make sure to open up invitation to the Step 3 technical committee at the Stakeholder Meeting
- Check with Darrin Walenta and Mike Burton if they would be able to give a Step 3 kick off presentation on agricultural efficiencies and economic impact in the basin
- Next Stakeholder Meeting we will explain ideas we want to implement to make our process better, including Parking Lot and adding water story/visioning element to our process
- It was decided to send out the responses to all comments from April 12 meeting and ask people to review them before our June 21 meeting and then provide an opportunity at the meeting for people to bring up comments that they would like to discuss further.
- It was decided to have the stakeholders brainstorm our group's responses to the IWRS 2017 document at the June 21 meeting (via sticky notes on poster)
- Potential future meeting dates of:
 - July 6th (9-11 stakeholder committee, then 11-12 steering committee)
 - July 28th (8-12 stakeholder Field Trip!)
 - August 14th (steering committee meeting)
 - August 16th (Stakeholder meeting to wrap up step 2 and kick off step 3)
