O R D E R

ON THIS DAY this matter came on to be heard upon the sworn  
petition of Harley McDonald and Lottie McDonald that their farm, located  
the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section 29, Township 1 North,  
Range 39 E. W. M., and the West half of the Northwest Quarter of  
section 28, Township 1 North, Range 39, E. W.M., Union County, Oregon,  
is not reached conveniently by any public road provided by law; and  
that it is necessary that the public and said McDonald's have ingress  
to and egress from said farm and asking the Court to appoint a Board of  
County Viewers; cause an order to be issued directing the viewers to  
meet at a time therein specified, not less than ten days from the  
making of the order; and making an order notifying the person or  
persons owning the land across which the roadway or a gateway is to  
be established, notifying them of the time and place of the meeting;  
and the Court being fully advised in the premises, and the applicable  
provisions of ORS 376.105, et. seq., does hereby order as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Burns Bailey, Glenn Sands  
and Lawrence Greiner be and they hereby are appointed  
as a Board of County Viewers.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board of County Viewers be  
and they hereby are directed to meet along the County road near the  
Northwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of  
Section 29, Township 1 North, Range 39 E.W.M., at the hour of 10:00 A.M.,  
on Monday, the 24th day of April, 1967, and then and

there to view out, locate and mark out either a suitable public road not exceeding 60 feet wide, or a gateway not less than ten nor more than thirty feet wide, or both, as may be found best by the Viewers, having regard to all surrounding circumstances and conditions of the case and so as to do the least damage to the lands through which the road or gateway is located from the farm of the McDonalds to the nearest point practicable on the County Road; to assess the damages sustained; and make a report to the County Court at its next regular session, on the 3rd day of May, 1967, of the public road or gateway located, the amount of damages assessed and the person entitled to such damages.


