KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned, in consideration of the grading and rocking of approximately 2,500 feet of road extending from the SE corner of NW1 of SW1 Section 23 T3S R4OE and running west to the point of intersection with the Cove-Moss Springs road, do hereby authorize and empower said Union County, Oregon, and its agents and employees, to do and perform the following acts, to wit:

1. To utilize a tract of land described hereafter for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a county road. Said tract of land to start at the SE corner of NW2 of SW2 Section 23 T8S R40E, running two rods south, thence directly west to the Cove-Moss Springs road, thence in a north-west direction along the Cove-Moss Springs road to appoint directly west from the point of beginning, and thence east to the point of beginning.

Dear Judge Misener:

I am returning herewith the two Easements and the proposed Order of acceptance which you sent to me for examination.

I believe the Easements are binding and legal. It would have been better if they had recited that the signers were husband and wife, but, in lieu thereof, I believe it could be proved by other testimony, if the question ever came up. Likewise, signatures to documents of conveyance are ordinarily "acknowledged" before a Notary, rather than being sworn to, but I do not believe this affects the legality of the instruments.

With respect to the proposed Order, I am enclosing a form which I believe would more clearly set forth the County's obligation, though I think a Court would probably construe the one you sent me as binding.
