ORDER OF ROAD RECLASSIFICATION

On this day this matter came on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.570 and ORS 368.580 did consider the matter of the vacation of Keys Woodruff County Road lying west of County Road No. 30 to a point north of Catherine Creek.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that the said County Road is burdensome to maintain, is not needed as a part of the County Road System but should continue to be a public road, and the public will be benefited thereby.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County road and depending thereon for access will be adversly affected by its reclassification.

The Court further agrees to raise the existing bridge an approximate three (3) feet and to grade the road and bridge approach in accord with existing road maintenance standards, with this work to be given the highest priority.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that the portion of Keys Woodruff County Road heretofore described be declared a road of public easement and no longer a county road, pursuant to the map attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".


