## FINDINGS OF FACT

RAMO FLAT COUNTY ROAD

AS A ROAD OF PUBLIC USE

The County Court finds that the said portion of County Road is burdensome to maintain, is not needed as a part of the County Road system, has not been used as a part of said County Road system for several years, is not distinguishable on the ground as a roadway; and this portion of Ramo Flats Road is a completely isolated part of the County Road system.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County Road and depending thereon for access will be adversely affected by its closure.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of Ramo Flats County Road No.69 from the cattle guard at the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 40 East of the Williamette Meridian extending approximately one and one-quarter (1.25) miles south, then westerly about one (1) mile to its intersection with Oregon Highway No.237 be vacated pursuant to the map attached hereto and marked Exhibit #1.
