WHEREAS, Union County received a Petition for Vacation from Union County Economic Development Corporation on August 23, 1988, to vacate a portion of the right-of-way of the former route of the La Grande-Baker Highway, State Primary Highway No.66 (203), in the vicinity of Hot Lake;

WHEREAS, Union County received the subject property from the State Highway Commission by resolution on February 22, 1972 because this portion was no longer needed for state highway right-of-way purposes;

WHEREAS, the subject portion of right-of-way has not been used by Union County for roadway purposes and is not planned to be used for roadway purposes in the future.

WHEREAS, Union County has processed the Vacation Petition according to ORS 368.326 through 368.426 provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, Union County orders the vacation of the following described public property to be vested in adjacent property described as Twp. 4S, Range 39 EWM, Section 5, Tax Lot 600:

All the land within the right-of-way boundaries of the La Grande-Baker Highway, State Primary Highway No. 66 as formerly routed lying outside of the northerly right-of-way boundaries of said La Grande-Baker Highway as now relocated from the west line of Section 4, Township 4S, Range 39 EWM, Union County, Oregon, to the westerly right-of-way line of Union County Road No. 29, all running through Tax Lot 600. Also including that portion abutting the north side of existing State Highway 203 and the east side of Union County Road No. 29 adjacent to Tax Lot 600.
