WHEREAS, the following county road segment is proposed to be transferred: any part of South 12th Street in County Road jurisdiction beginning at its intersection with Gekeler Lane extending south to a point 130 feet north of the center of rightof-way intersection with Lakeview Lane.

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners advertised in accordance to ORS 373.270 (2)(b) and held a public hearing to accept public testimony on the proposed jurisdiction transfer.

NOW THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF OREGON:

SECTION 1: SURRENDER OF JURISDICTION OFFER

The jurisdiction of the following county road segment is offered to the City of La Grande (see attached map): Any part of South 12th Street in County Road jurisdiction beginning at its intersection with Gekeler lane extending south to a point 130 feet north of the center of right-of-way intersection with Lakeview Lane.

SECTION 2: TIME LIMIT OF ACCEPTANCE

The Union County Board of Commissioners allows the City of La Grande six months (July 18, 2012) to accept the offered street segment. This offer will expire at the end of that time period if not acted on.
