WHEREAS, The Union County Court, meeting in special session on June 18, 1980 did hold a public hearing to consider the recommendation of the Union County Planning Commission to approve the application of Mark D. Sweet to establish an access road off of Starr Lane to a proposed 10 acre parcel located within Twp. 2S, Range 38 EMM, Sections 8 and 17, Tax Lot 2512 situated in Union County.

CONDITIONS

1. Legal raod access be provided for not less than a 30 foot right-of-way width access to the 10 acres.
2. The current road surface is found to be adequate.
