it appears that said penalty and interest accumulated on the taxes for the year 1911 without fault of said George Miller, and that said penalty and interest should be refunded

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the County Clerk draw a warrant on the General fund of the county to George Miller in the sum of \$26.67, as a refund of penalty and interest charged and collected on the 1911 taxes of said George Miller.

In the matter of the application of the Grande Ronde Lumber Company to build logging road over County road.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of the Grande Ronde Lumber Company for permission to build a temporary logging road on certain county roads in Section 20, Tp. 3 S. R. 37 E. and it appearing to the court that said application should be granted.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be granted and that said Grande Ronde Lumber Company be allowed to build a temporary logging road over and upon said county roads upon condition that the county road be kept in repair for travel and in condition for actual use by the public.

In the matter of the application of the Union Livestock Show Association for an appropriation.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of the Union Livestock Show Association by Geo. W. Benson, its President, and Geo. A. Scibird, its Secretary, for an appropriation of \$350.00 to be used by said Association for the purpose of advertising the Union Livestock Show to be held at Union on June 5, 6 and 7, 1913, and it appearing to the court that said Union Livestock Show Association is an organization in the interest of the livestock industry of the entire county and that such an appropriation would advertise the resources of the county.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be granted and the Clerk of this court is hereby directed to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the county in favor of Geo. W. Benson, President of said Association, for the sum of \$350.00 to be used in advertising Union County through the medium of the Union Livestock Show.

In the matter of the payment to the Coast Bridge Company for steel bridge near Imbler, Oregon.

It appearing to the court at this time that under the terms of the contract entered into between this court and the Coast Bridge Company, payment is now due for a steel bridge heretofore delivered by said company to Union County and erected over the Grande Ronde River near Imbler, and it further appearing that the contract price of said bridge is \$3160.00 and that the time of payment is April 1st, and that said payment should now be made.
