O R D E R

Pursuant to a Resolution adopted by the County Court of Union County, Oregon, on the 18th day of April 1975, and in accordance with ORS 368.570, it is hereby

ORDERED that the County Roadmaster examine that portion of County Road No. 563, more particularly described in Exhibit "B", attached hereto, located in Union County, Oregon, as the same appears on the attached Exhibit "A" and make a report in writing on the road on or before May 1, 1975.

This report shall include the opinion of the Roadmaster as to whether the road should be vacated, whether the road is or has been in use as a part of the County road system, whether it will be advisable to preserve the road as a part of the general road system in the future or whether the public will be benefited by the vacation of said County road, and all other facts, matter, and things which are of importance to the County Court,

Upon completion of this report, it shall be filed with the County Cler, and a copy thereof furnished to the County Court

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that June 4, 1975, at 10:00 AM.M, in the County Courtroom in the Courthouse in the City of La Grande, Oregon, will hereby be the fixed time and place for the hearing of said report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Roadmaster of Union County, Oregon, or one of his authorized representatives, be ordered and directed to cause notice of the hearing to be given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court (Union County Courthouse), and at three public places in the vicinity of the road, at least thirty (30) days before the date set for the hearing, and proof that the notice has been given shall be made by the Raodmaster of Union County, Oregon, or his authorized representative.

ROADS IN SECTION 4 T6S R39E. W.M.






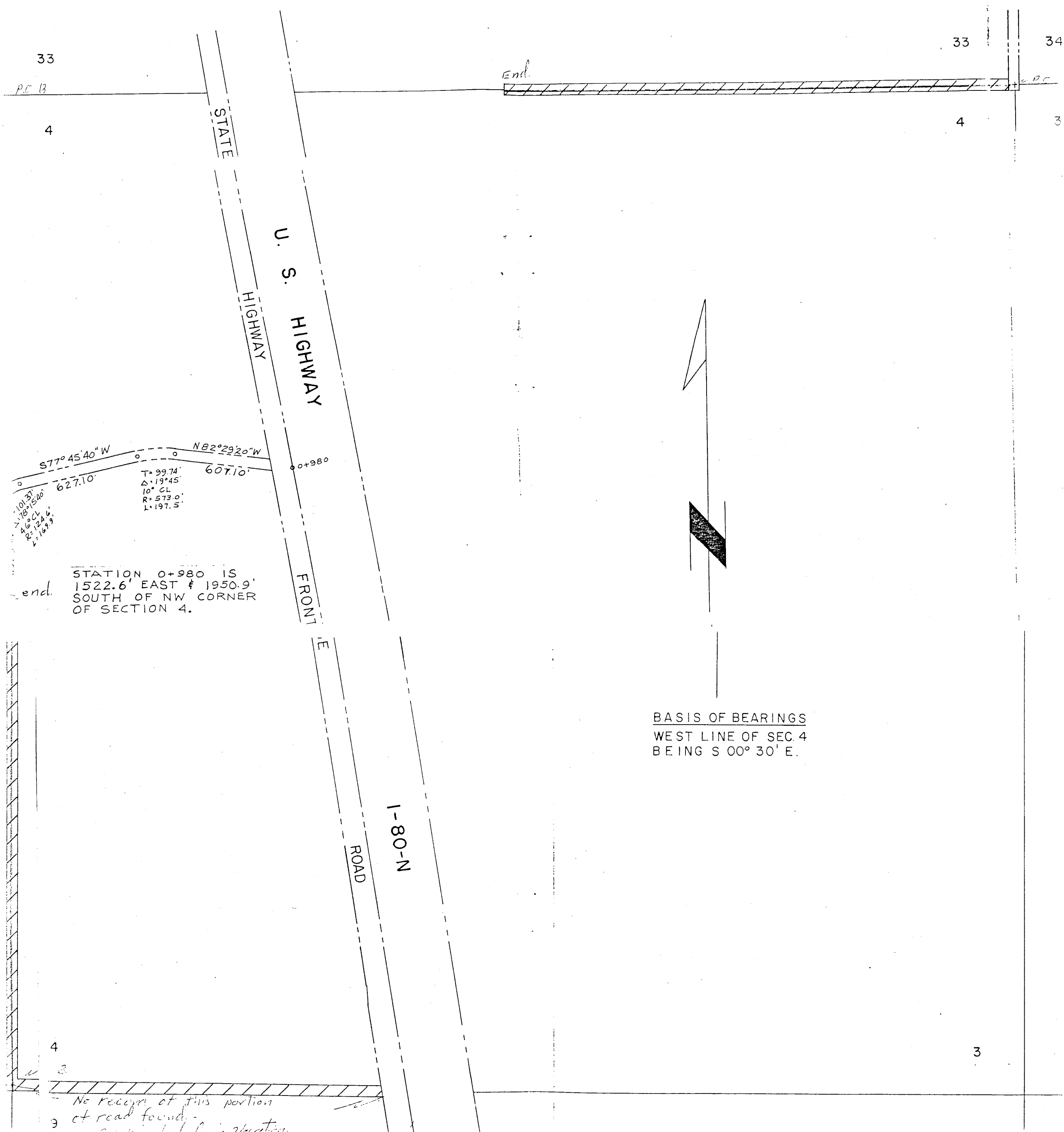

I wish to report on April 28th, 1975 in pursuance with your order of the 18th day of April, 1975, I proceeded to survey the portions of Road No. 563 per the following legal description:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM and running thence south on west boundary of Section 4 a distance of 2040 Feet M/L to intersection of road as recorded in Book 125 Page 250 of deed records of Union County.

Commencing at the southwest corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM and running north on the west boundary of said Section 4 a distance of 2640 feet more or less to intersection of road as recorded in Book 125 at Page 250 of deed records of Union County.

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM and running west to north one quarter corner of said Section 4.

I recommend closing the portions of Road No. 563 as described for I feel it has no more usefulness in our County Road System.

3. That portion of the road to be vacated is not used as a part of the County road system.
4. It is useless as a part of the general road system, dangerous, and a unnecessary maintenance burden upon the County and,
5. The public and the County would benefited by its vacation, and

WHEREAS, the County Court, on its own motion, desire to vacated said portion of County Road known as County Road No. 563 as the same appears on the attached map marked Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, Julie Campbell has the qualifications for election to such office and it being in the public interest that Julie Campbell be appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace protem for a period not to exceed sixty days; it is hereby

ORDERED that Julie Campbell is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace protem for the La Grande Justice of the Peace District. Said period of service is to begin June 9, 1975 for a period of one week to end June 15, 1975.

ORDER OF ROAD VACATION

On this day this matter came on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.570 and ORS 368.580 did consider the matter of the vacation of that portion of County Road No. 563, to-wit:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM and running thence south on west boundary of said Section 4 a distance of 2040 feet M/E to intersection of road as recorded in Book 125 at Page 250 of deed records of Union County.

Commencing at the southwest corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM, and running north on the west boundary of said Section 4 a distance of 2640 feet M/L to intersection of road as recorded in Book 125 at Page 250 of deed records of Union County.

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 4, T6S, R39EWM, and running west to north one quarter corner of said Section 4.

as the same appears on the attached map marked Exhibit "A."

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that:

1. A portion of the County road No. 563 to be vacated has never been used as a County Road, is unimproved and,
2. A new road has been built to provide access to parties residing in the area,
3. That portion of the road to be vacated is not used as a part of the County road system,
4. It is useless as part of the general road system, dangerous, and a unnecessary maintenance burden upon the County, and
5. The public and the County would be benefited by its vacation.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County Road and depending thereon for access will be adversely affected by its closure.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of County Road No. 563 be vacated pursuant to the map attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A", and by this reference, incorporated herein.
