
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Joseph G. Gray under GLO joint contract, with William H. Odell, No. 120, dated May 27, 1867. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set 1/4 section corner post deposited marked stone, and raised stone mound as per instructions.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2' diameter mound of stone in East/West bearing fences. No marked stone found.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position of found stone mound, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" aluminum cap marked as shown, 25" in the ground, with mound of stone 3' base to top of cap.

From which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 87°02' West, a distance of 20.42 feet, with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap bears marked N RP.

A $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin bears South 86°19' East, a distance of 16.57 feet, with $1 \frac{1}{2}"$ aluminum cap marked E RP.

A Rock Outcrop bears South 16°10' West, a distance of 51.48 feet, marked X BO. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 26°12' West, distance of 18.49, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked W RP.

A fence corner bears West approx. 9 feet from which fence bear East, West, and North.


