



A 15 inch Douglas Fir bears N27°E, a distance of 56.60 feet, marked CN 1/16 BT. A 15 inch Douglas Fir bears N34°W, a distance of 38.40 feet, marked CN 1/16 BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 18° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown of the bearing tree. A brass washer marked OPLS 2219 is attached to the BT blaze.
