HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450 dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set a basalt stone 18 x 12 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face, raised mound of stone alongside, pits impracticable,

In 1979 James H. Hambleton found the stone. Union County Monumentation Record 129-84R states: At assumed corner location I found a 16 x 11 x 6" basalt stone 8" above ground in good condition with 1/4 on W. face. Stone found in a small mound of stone. Set a 2" galv. iron pipe with brass cap approx. 12" above the ground surface in a mound of stone and placed original stone upside down along W. edge of monument. Cap stamped as shown above. A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears South 77° East a dist. of 40.20 ft., alive and vigorous with healed blaze.




