A Pine $8^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears $545^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 63 \mathrm{lks}$.
A Pine $10^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears $N 60^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 37 \mathrm{ks}$.
A Pine $18^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears $580^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 87 \mathrm{lks}$.
Monumentation sheet $801-84 \mathrm{R}$ states finding a 8 " rotted pine stump with axe marks at the northeast original BT position, and a 14 " decayed sawed pine stump with scribes visible at the southeast
 original BT position. A $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below was set, from which:
A 12" fir bears $\mathrm{N} 70^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 43$ lks, marked T1S R40E S19 BT.
A $12^{\prime \prime}$ fir bears $\mathrm{S} 28^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 37 \mathrm{lks}$, marked T1S R40E S30 BT.
A 14" fir bears $S 11^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$, 35 lks , marked T1S R39E S25 BT.
A $13^{\prime \prime}$ fir bears $\mathrm{N} 67^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 31.5$ lks, marked T1S R39E S24 BT.
No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:
No evidence of the original bearing trees was found.
Found $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe monument with $3^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap, marked as shown below. The northeast $B T$ is know a $16 "$ White Fir alive and vigorous with scribes visible. The southwest and northwest BT's are now stumps with scribes visible.
