An 18" Spruce bears S64°E., 21.5 ft. scribed 1/4S36 BT. A 22" Spruce bears N37°W., 52.4 ft. scribed 1/4S35 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
