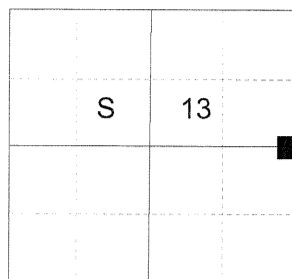


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Rufus S. Moore under GLO joint contract number 382 dated March 23rd, 1881. Surveyor General field notes state:
 Set Post for 1/4 sec. cor. from which:
 A pine 36 ins. diam. bears N70°E 12 lks. dist.
 A pine 28 ins. diam. bears N53°W 153 lks. dist.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

A 41" Ponderosa Pine bears North 70° East, a dist. of 7.92 feet, alive and vigorous with faint "B" scribing visible on a partially burnt and healed blaze. BLM bearing tree tag states "8 ft. to corner, Nov. 1957".
 A 31" Ponderosa Pine bears North 53° West, a dist. of 100.98 feet, alive and vigorous with faint "1/4" scribes visible on a partially burnt and healed blaze.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At record distance and bearing from the faces of the trees, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 24" in the ground with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South a dist. of 22.50 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked S RP. Falls approx. 2 1/2 feet East of old power pole.
 A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 68° West a dist. of 11.05 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP. Falls in Railroad right of way fence line.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 foot South.

Falls North of railroad right of way fence approx. 9 feet.

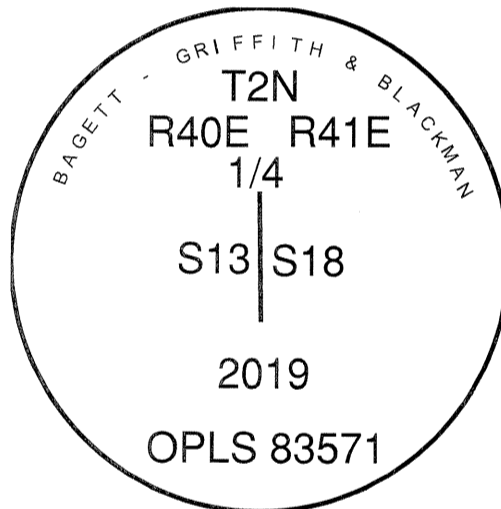
