All BT's have a red painted stripe and BT tags. The new BT's have a brass washer stamped RLS 346 nailed to the lower blaze. There is a $6^{\circ}$ steel fence post within $5^{\circ}$ of the corner.

There is a red painted and blazed line running North and South through this corner.
