A Pine 30 ins. diam. bears S80 E, 22lks, dist. marked 1/4 S.B.T.."

Description of corner evidence found:

Found loose 10" x 10" x 8" stone and wood stick.

No marks found on stone.

Two large Pines appear to be record BTs and at a point are: A Pine 33" in dia. bears S80°E, 14.9 feet, face scribed 1/4S. A Pine 33" in dia. bears N60°W, 10.9 feet, face with grown over blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2½" x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap marked: Set pipe 24" in the ground, and placed stone at base of pipe.
