
History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Rufus S. Moore, Contract No. 437. Commenced July, 1882, and completed August, 1883.

40.00 set a pine post 3 feet long, 3 inches square 24 inches in ground. From which:

A pine 7 inches diameter bears N 43° W 5 lks. dist. A pine 7 inches diameter bears S 72° E 10 lks. dist.



NEW BEARING TREES:


A 7" Douglas Fir bears North 22° East, a distance of 22.20 feet, marked 1/4S7 BT. A 14" Douglas Fir bears South 10° East, a distance of 53.70 feet, marked 1/4S7 BT. A 7" Douglas Fir bears South 24° West, a distance of 17.75 feet, marked 1/4S12 BT. An 8" Douglas Fir bears North 44° West, a distance of 19.90 feet, marked 1/4S12 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearing is to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the tree. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the tree.
