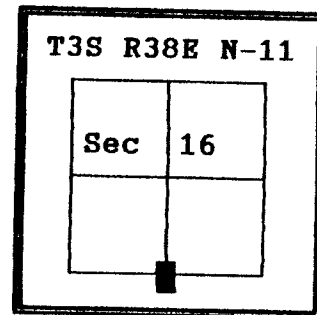


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by David P. Thompson under GLO contract no. 103, dated September 3, 1863. Surveyor General record states:

I set post for 1/4 corner to secs 16 and 21, in mound of earth, dug pits;

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Fence corner, fences N-E-W. These fences have been here for many years. Other surveys in the area have shown the harmony of this position as the one quarter corner. I accept this position as the 1/4 corner common to sections 16 and 21 on the basis of best available evidence.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position as described above, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 25" in the ground, from which;

- A 5/8" X 30" rebar bears N87°E, 5.81 feet, with aluminum cap marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR NE RP"
- A 5/8" X 30" rebar bears S21°E, 16.63 feet, with aluminum cap marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR SE RP"
- A 5/8" X 30" rebar bears S81°W, 13.61 feet, with aluminum cap marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR SW RP"
- A 5/8" X 30" rebar bears N10°W, 14.36 feet, with aluminum cap marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR NW RP"

Drove steel fence post 10± feet west, with LCM sign.

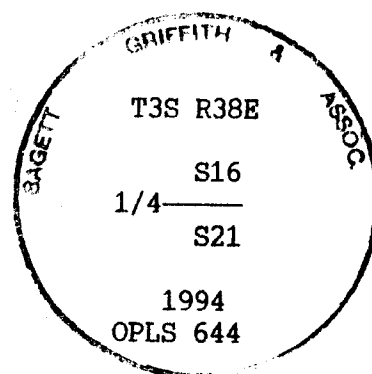

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to the center of the aluminum cap on the rebar.
