

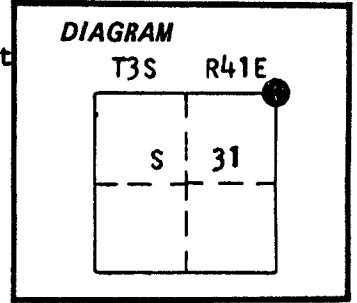
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract number 683 dated June 7, 1898. Surveyor General record states:

Set basalt stone 14x10x4 ins for cor to secs 29,30,31 and 32 from which;

- A fir 8 in diam bears N71°E 10 lks dist
- A black pine 10 in diam bears S64°E 40 lks dist
- A fir 16 in diam bears S55°30'W 27 lks dist
- A black pine 14 in diam bears N48°W 27 lks dist



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records

Description of corner evidence found:

Stone 14"x9"x4" with grooves visible, also 3/4"x24" iron pipe alongside.

The remains of a Fir bears S 55 1/2° W, 27 lks. Dead and down badly rotted with chop marks visible.

A skid road running East and West 20 feet North of corner, destroyed the Northwest and Northeast bearing trees and the North line tree.

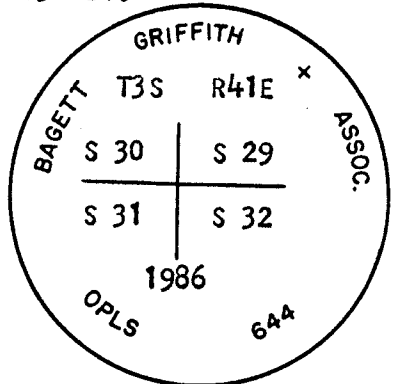

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the stone position I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown 28 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 2 foot base to top of cap, from which:

- A 10 inch Douglas Fir bears N 43° E, 30.88 feet, marked T3S R41E S29 BT.
- An 11 inch Tamarack bears S 59° E, 23.45 feet, marked T3S R41E S32 BT.
- An 8 inch Tamarack bears S 65° W, 25.57 feet, marked T3S R41E S31 BT.
- A 6 inch Tamarack bears N 57° W, 19.10 feet, marked X BT.

A rotted fir stump, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 43° E., 30.6 ft. dist., no marks visible.

A tamarack, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 59° E., 23.4 ft. dist., with a healed blaze.

A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 65° W., 25.6 ft. dist., with a healed blaze.

A tamarack, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W., 19.5 ft. dist., with a healed blaze.

a bearing tree mkd. by person(s) unknown

A lodgepole pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 53° W., 3.1 ft. dist., with a rotted blaze, no scribing visible.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 10 1/2° E., 29.6 ft. dist., mkd. X at breast height and BT at base.

S. 1° 51' 00" E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Dirt road, 14 ft. wide, bears S. 30° E. and N. 30° W.
