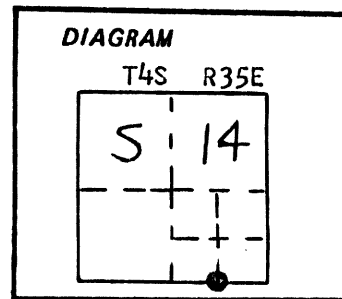

At position determined by survey I set a 2 1/2' x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground from which:

A 16" Tamarack bears S23°E, 49.60 feet, marked E 1/16 S23 BT

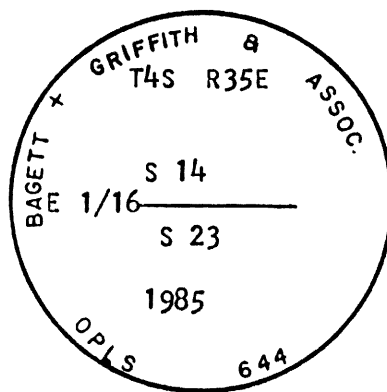
A 10" Douglas Fir bears N44°W, 20.29 feet, marked E 1/16 S14 BT

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with 54-4 and 54-2 sign attached.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with 54-2 sign attached.
