CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUME...ATION


History of original corner establishment:

The original survey of Township 4 South, Range 38 East was performed by W. B. Barr under GLO Contract No. 388, dated May 7, 1881.

Record states:

Marked volcanic rock $16 \times 14 \times 12$ ins. for 1/4 sec. cor. from which:

Fir 24 ins. diam. bears S. 250 E., 25 lks. dist. Fir 12 ins. diam. bears S. 840 W., 12 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found vesicular basalt stone 16 x 14 x 10 ins. marked with 1/4 on downward face, lying in a 6 stone mound, from which:

A stump hole bears S. 25° E., 16.5 feet dist., no trace of bearing tree other than bark remains.

A Douglas Fir 22 ins. diam. stump, sawed 4.5 feet height bears S. 84° W., 7.9 feet dist., marked with 1/4 scribe visible on open face and faint lower trunk scar.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the point of the recovered corner stone, set a $2lac{1}{2}-in$. brass cap on a $1lac{1}{4}-in$. diam. galv. iron pipe, 30 ins. long, 26 ins. into the ground andconstructed a 36-in. diam. stone mound around it. Buried the original stone 1 ft. North of the monument. Cap is marked as shown in the above corner diagram.

From the corner point:

A 12 in. diam. white fir bears N. 73 $^{\rm O}$ W., 40.9 ft. dist., mkd. $^{1}\!\!\!/_{\!\! 4}$ S6 BT on a double blaze.

A secure basalt stone 18 ins. x 18 ins. protruding 6 ins. above ground bears N. 71° E., 11.8 ft. dist., mkd. X BO on the Southerly sloping face.

A secure basalt stone 36 ins. x 30 ins. protruding 6 ins. above ground bears S. 32⁰ W., 18 ft. dist. mkd. X BO on top.

A secure basalt stone 24 ins. x 12 ins. protruding 6 ins. above ground bears S. 77^o E., 17.6 ft. dist., mkd. X BO on top.

Set a steel fence post 3 ft. East of the corner with USFS 54-9 sign attached. Also attached 54-3 tag to original bearing tree and both 54-9 sign and 54-3 tag to the new bearing tree.
