

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

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HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by W.B. Barr under GLO contract 388, dated May 7, 1881. Surveyor General field notes state:

Marked basalt rock 16x10x6 for 1/4 sec. corner, from which:

Pine 16 in. diam. bears N67°E, 94 lks. dist. Pine 36 in. diam. bears S57°W, 182 lks. dist.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a prominent mound of stone, approx. 4 ft. diam., from which:

A stump hole bears North $67^{\circ}E$, 62 ft. dist., with an uprooted pine stump alongside, in a state of decay and has been previously burnt, original size indeterminate. No scribe marks visible.

A decaying pine stump, original size indeterminate, bears South 57° West, a distance of 120 feet, no scribe marks visible.

A series of stone mounds extend North and South, likely remains of an ancient fenceline. Due to harmony with stump pattern as well as with the Section corner to the West, I accept this mound of stone as being the best available evidence of the original GLO corner.

A 13 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 73° East, a distance of 79.15 feet, marked 1/4 S17 BT.

A 5 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 41° East, a distance of 133.20 feet, marked 1/4 S20 BT.

A 14 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 87° West, a distance of 72.35 feet, marked 1/4 S20 BT.


An 11 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 28° West, a distance of 75.30 feet, marked 1/4 S17 BT.


Corner falls approx. 150 feet North of an East/West running logging road. I hereby certify that this monument was set July 19, 2016.

I use a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Distances to the new trees are to a spike in the root crown of the trees. Bearings are to a brass washer in the lower blaze marked OPLS 83571.
