

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which,

- A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South $40^{\circ}12$ ' East, a distance of 20.17 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked SERP.
- A $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin bears South $48^{\circ}22'$ West, a distance of 20.97 feet, with 1 12" aluminum cap marked SWRP.
- I set a steel fencepost approximately 6 inches West of the corner monument.
- I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on August 13, 2013.
