

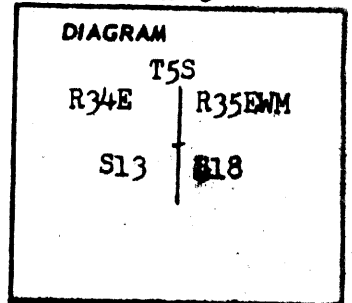

The original notes read;
Run north on west side of Sec 18 and set a post from which;
A pine 32" in diam bears N83°W 52 lks dist marked †SBT
A pine 14" in diam bears S27°E 57 lks dist marked †SBT



Description of corner evidence found:

Found - A pine stump bears S27°E
A pine stump and log bears N83°W

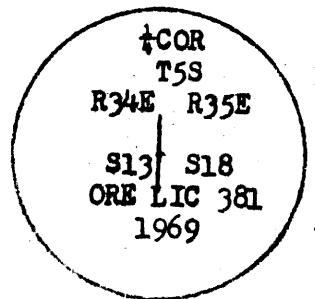

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long with a bronze cap on top and 8" plated welded to bottom Pipe set to a depth of 18" and backfilled with stone and soil and raised a stone monument;

I stamped the disk



From the corner the original bearing trees are - none;
I set the following new bearing trees ;
A pine 10" in diam bears N29°E 8.5 ft. marked †SBT
A pine 10" in diam bears N55°W 24.2 ft. marked †SBT
(distance to center of trees and marked with scribe)
I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. USFS bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the monument.
