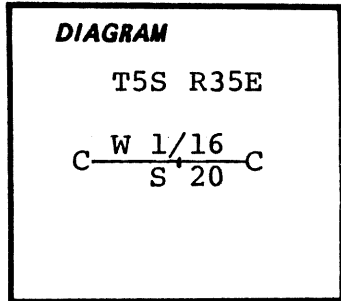

- An 8" L. Pine bears N86.5°E, 20.6 ft., blazed and scribed: CW 1/16 S20 BT.

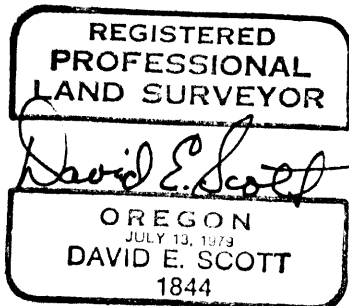

Corner is found on north slope 40 ft. below ridge top. Take road 5155 0.4 mi. past Blue Springs. Walk east up ridge to posted line.
