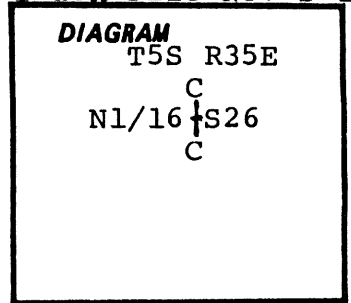


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

This is not an original GLO corner.



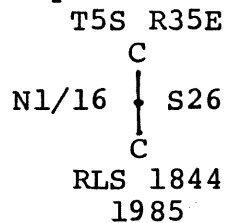
Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner set by subdivision. Set 2.5"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

Cap is stamped:



New BT's:

- 7" Fir bears N38.25°W 5.5 ft., blazed and scribed: CN1/16 S26 BT.
- 6" P. Pine bears N71.5°W, 15.0 ft., blazed and scribed: CN1/16 S26 BT.

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. Brass disk stamped "LS 1844" nailed to lower end of blazes.

Corner is in timber 30' south of intersection of Roads 5100-290 and 5100-233. Take Road 51 to Road 5100-295 through fence, past pond to Road 5100-290, then east to corner.
