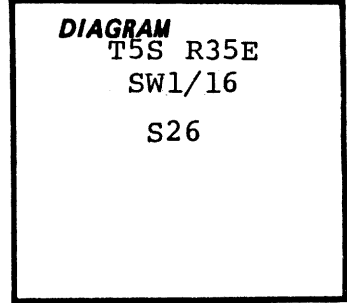

Set a 2.5"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. west of corner.

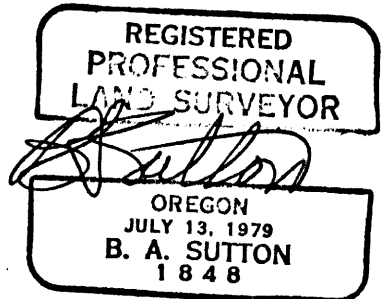
- 3" Tamarack bears S18.75°E, 64.6 ft., blazed and scribed; X BT.
- 6" Black Pine bears N46.5°W, 49.1 ft., blazed and scribed: SW1/16 S26 BT.

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. Brass disk stamped "LS 1844" nailed to lower end of blazes.

Corner is located in cleared area 18 ft. south of east-west fence, 50 ft. west of fence corner. Take Road 51 to Raad 5155, then 0.2 miles to cattle guard and forest boundary. Corner is 300 ft. south.
