Thence South two miles, Thence in a generally South Eastly direction to the N.W. corner of <sup>2</sup>Quinn's Homestead. (Or the N.W. corner of R.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 22, Township 2) Thence South 1/2 mile to Terminus

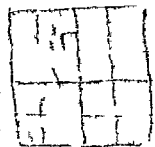
