CHAINS. LKS.

Survey made May 30 1913 for Carl Cowan,
Frank McKinnis, Geo. Slack, et. al. Sec. 27
Twp. 1 North Range 38 E N. 7M.

First measured and established $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor on north
line.

Found and established corners as follows.

SE Cor. located by testimony Jim and Bert Slack.

Old fence corner and bearing trees.

$\frac{1}{4}$ Cor on south side, located by testimony of Jim and Geo. Slack also
by fence corner.

SW Cor. located by old fence corner. (I set stone 1000 cu. in marked with chisel marks)

$\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. West side. Old rotted stake with $\frac{1}{4}$ mark and mound of earth.
(I set large stone marked $\frac{1}{4}$ and left stake at corner.)

Center of section placed stone marked C.S. at intersection of straight
lines from $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor to $\frac{1}{4}$ Corners at opposite sides.

$\frac{1}{4}$ Cor on East side. located by testimony of Mr. Sanderson, also by old
fence corner. (I set a large stone marked $\frac{1}{4}$.)

NE Cor. located by a large pile of stones & testimony of D.L. Sanderson.

NW Cor. " " Stone and witness trees, (I marked stone with proper
chisel marks)

$\frac{1}{4}$ Cor on north side set a stake 4" square marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. at a point
equal distant from the NW and NE Corners and on a straight line
between said corners.
