County Measure

31-104 FIVE-YEAR LOCAL OPTION LEVY FOR CONTROL OF INVASIVE NOXIOUS WEEDS

Question: Shall Union County levy \$.12 per \$1,000 assessed value for five years starting with 2021-22 for noxious weed control? "This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent."

Summary: The invasion of noxious weeds is one of the most serious environmental and economic threats to Union County. The value of our natural resources and our agricultural economy needs to be protected from invasive species. As residents of Union County we need to continue to support efforts to control and manage noxious weeds. With passage of the Local Option Levy for Noxious Weed Control in 2016, the County used those dedicated funds to hire a full-time County Weed Supervisor who has developed a successful and comprehensive weed management program covering all of Union County.

An estimated \$230,000 would be available annually as a result of this levy. This tax would cost the owner of a home with an assessed value of \$100,000 a total of \$12 per year. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate.

1-108 BOND TO UPGRADE MAINTENANCE SYSTEMS, CONSTRUCT SCHOOL CAFETERIA, IMPROVE SAFETY

Question: Shall District issue \$4,000,000 in bonds and receive \$4,000,000 grant to upgrade maintenance systems, construct school cafeteria and improve safety? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: The District will receive a \$4,000,000 state matching grant only if bonds are approved. Bonds and grant funds are expected to finance capital costs, including:

- Replace/upgrade mechanical and electrical systems at all schools to provide heating, cooling and ventilation
- Construct approximately 5,000 square foot multipurpose building at Baker Middle School for use as cafeteria/kitchen
- Replace roof at South Baker Intermediate
- Upgrade security and access systems at all schools, including key cards, door sensors, security cameras, fire alarms and public address systems
- Add secure entry vestibules at Brooklyn Primary and South Baker Intermediate
- Site improvements, furnishings, equipment, bond issuance costs

Citizen oversight committee will be formed to ensure proceeds are used as intended.

Bonds would mature in not to exceed 5 years from issuance and may be issued in one or more series. Estimated average tax rate is \$0.66 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual levy rate may differ due to changes in interest rates and assessed value.
