RE: Request for Proposal – Law Enforcement Night Vision Equipment

Union County Sheriff's Office, a division of Union County, Oregon is requesting proposals for night vision equipment meeting the following minimum requirements. The equipment will be purchased and not leased.

Specifications:

Eight (8) – Gen III P45 White Phosphor dual tube Night Vision Goggle. Must include a hard case, soft case, eye cups, sacrificial windows, Non-Variable gain system, dovetail mounting platform and operations manual.

Eight (8) – Rifle mounted visible green or red laser, IR illuminator and designator device with tape switch.

Eight (8) – Wilcox or comparable mounts to mount RNVG to helmet.

One (1) - Night vision unit that mounts in front of an existing day scope and converts the day scope to a night vision scope, effective up to ranges of 1000 yards. Can be mounted to or removed from a standard Picatinny rail with no tools required. For use with day scopes of up to 10x magnification.

Please respond to this request by email no later than 9am on May 19, 2023 with a proposal that includes:

- Equipment manufacturer(s) and model numbers.
- Included options and specifications.
- Indicate in-stock availability, and if not available in-stock, please indicate ability to deliver to La Grande, OR. by June 30, 2023.
- The total, final price including shipping and handling.
- The length of time for which the proposal is valid.
